

Are you new to RV towing? We have numerous customers that are in the same boat trying to learn where to start, what to buy and how to watch their spending without skimping on the important stuff.

First, if you are not sure about the technical stuff please call (800.810.4918) or Chat (use the Chat window in the bottom right of your screen) with us anytime. We want you to tow safely and know which hitch will work with your specific truck and RV. Knowing exactly what you need can save you thousands of dollars by avoiding the wrong combination of truck, hitch and 5th wheel trailer.

Second, you obviously need three main items to get started. 1. Truck 2. Hitch 3. 5th Wheel Trailer/RV. Now, choosing these three items is harder than it seems. The kind of truck you use will determine the type of hitch you need. It can also expand or limit the type of 5th wheel RV's that you can safely tow. The more towing capacity the bigger the 5th wheel RV you can tow. The bigger the 5th wheel RV the higher the weight rating you need on your hitch. So, make sure you think through what you really want before you make a big purchase. You might consider selling your truck for a different towing capacity, or choosing a smaller 5th wheel trailer for smooth, safer towing.



Third, the hitch can be the simple or complex part. B&W offers a [family of hitches](#) to fit different needs and budgets. You have options that will help make your towing experience much more enjoyable.

1. We create a hitch that slides rearward in the bed of your truck so that you can gain more turning clearance if you have a short bed truck or a really long gooseneck 5th wheel trailer. [The Companion Slider](#).

3. We design a hitch that fits newer model trucks that have the 4 holes already drilled in their truck bed. These holes with pucks are drilled at the truck factories and only work with specific hitches. Be careful before buying a truck with this system, because it may limit your choices.
